
**Project** : Tissue holder 1



## Supplies Needed :






- 8.5" x 11" paper
- Straight Edge
- Facial tissue
- Bone folder (optional) for creasing folds

## Directions :

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Crease an 8 1/2-by-11-inch piece of paper of lightweight cardstock, along the width in 3 places:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>1" from the top</li><li>6" from the top</li><li>9" from the top</li></ul></li></ol>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>2. Fold the first crease back (away from you)</li></ol>



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	<p>3. Fold the second crease up</p>
	<p>4. Fold the third crease down</p>
	<p>5. Folding along the creases will yield something that looks like this. (Front view)</p>
	<p>6. Rotate the paper 90 degrees and make a crease 2 1/4" from the top. Fold that back.</p>
	<p>7. Weave the back edges together, so that they are interlocked.</p>

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	<p>8. Weave the back edges together, so that they are interlocked.</p>
	<p>9. Turn packet over, decorate as desired, and insert tissues.</p>
